

POLISH LANGUAGE COURSE

PROGRAM OF STUDY

Number of hours: 600 (300 hours per semester)

1st Semester

The academic year starts with Orientation Week. During the week, newcomers familiarize themselves with the University's structure, meet their teachers, and learn about applicable university regulations, procedures for the legalization of their stay in Poland, and the Virtual University Platform (i.e. our internal information portal). Additionally during the first week, course participants undergo an assessment of their Polish skills, which helps us to place them in groups aligned with their level of language proficiency.

Throughout the first semester, participants work on improving their Polish competency. They acquire basic vocabulary and grammar skills, which allow them to start communicating in Polish, in everyday social situations. They also learn about Polish traditions, customs and culture. At the end of the semester, course participants write an exam, which helps us to measure their progress.

2nd Semester

During the second semester, participants further develop their speaking and writing skills. They work on team projects, which provide ample opportunities to practice communicating in Polish.

At the end of the semester, participants write the final test. The results of the test confirm participants' level of Polish competency and indicate whether a person can progress to the next level of learning.

The program closes with an official Graduation Ceremony, where Director for International Relations hands out Certificates of Polish Language Course Completion.
