RECOGNITION OF FOREIGN DIPLOMAS IN THE PROCESS OF APPLYING TO UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS OR FIVE-YEAR INTEGRATED GRADUATE STUDIES IN POLAND

1. Diplomas obtained abroad that do not require nostrification or legalization by Polish institutions

The following diplomas obtained abroad, which are legally recognized in Poland, do not require nostrification or legalization by Polish institutions. These document may be submitted directly to higher education institutions or employers without the need to obtain an opinion of other institutions or authorities on the territory of Poland.

 secondary school/high-school diplomas obtained in education systems of the member-states of the European Union, the European Free Trade Association – the European Economic Area, and the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development, i.e. diplomas or other documents confirming completion of secondary school education, which entitle the holders to apply to higher education institutions in the country where they were issued by schools or education institutions recognized by the country on whose territory and whose education system the school operates.

Currently, this refers to secondary school/high-school diplomas obtained in the following countries: Australia, Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, Croatia, Cyprus, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Great Britain, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Island, Israel, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxemburg, Malta, Mexico, New Zealand, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Sweden, Switzerland, South Korea, Spain, the Czech Republic, the Netherlands, the People's Republic of China, the United States, and Turkey.

- The International Baccalaureate (IB) diplomas issued by the International Baccalaureate (IB) Organization in Geneva.
- The European Baccalaureate (EB) diploma issued by European Schools, according to the Convention defining the status of European Schools, concluded in Luxemburg on 21 June 1994.
- diplomas under international agreements (currently: Belarus, China, and Ukraine).

2. Recognition of completed education by the Chief Education Officer

As the result of administrative procedure, a Chief Education Officer may recognize a foreign diploma as a document confirming primary, middle-level, vocational or secondary education.

The proceedings are conducted by the Chief Education Officer competent for the place of residence of the applicant or, in case the applicant does not have a permanent residence address in Poland, competent for the seat of the school or the higher education institution, where the application will submit the diploma (in Warsaw: CHIEF EDUCATION OFFICER IN WARSAW – address: Aleje Jerozolimskie 32, 00-024 Warsaw; tel.: +48 (0) 22, 551 24 00 ext. 5121; fax: +48 (0) 22 826 64 97; e-mail: kuratorium@kuratorium.waw.pl). A list of all offices of the Chief Education Officer is available here.



RECOGNITION OF FOREIGN DIPLOMAS IN THE PROCESS OF APPLYING TO GRADUATE PROGRAMS IN POLAND

If your diploma entitles you to continue studies at the graduate level in the higher education system where the issuing university operates, it also entitles you to continue education at the graduate level in Poland. The diploma is recognized pursuant to Article 326 sec. 1 and 2 of the Act of 20 July 2018 Law on Higher Education and Science [Dz. U. (Journal of Laws) 2018, item 1668 as amended].

A foreign diploma may also entitle you to further education in Poland pursuant to an international agreement (according to Article 327 sec. 1 of the Law).

If your diploma does not entitle you to education at the graduate level in the country where it was issued, but you still wish to continue your education in Poland, your diploma must undergo a process of nostrification, pursuant to the regulation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 28 September 2018 on recognition of higher education diploma from abroad and confirmation of higher education completion on certain level [Dz. U. (Journal of Laws) 1881].

The diploma nostrification procedure may be conducted by any higher education institution rated as scientific category A+, A, or B+ in the discipline related to the application of nostrification (pursuant to Article 327 sec. 4 of the Law).
