

Academic education is a teaching process adopted by higher education institutions with the aim of imparting knowledge to learners and fostering their skills and social competencies. At SWPS University, academic education encompasses degree programs, postgraduate programs, and other forms of education.

Strategic goal: By 2029, we envision ourselves as a University that offers high quality interdisciplinary education in various fields of study, providing learners with the flexibility to independently shape their educational journey.

Target Status: In 2029, SWPS University is committed to offering high quality academic teaching, degree programs, and other forms of education. Our educational programs combine theory with practice, leveraging the latest research and collaborations with foreign universities, economic and public entities, and social organizations. SWPS University accurately identifies and addresses the needs of society and the labor market from local, state-wide, and international perspectives. Drawing on their research, artistic activity, or professional experience, our academic employees offer interdisciplinary teaching in various fields, in both Polish and English. The university facilitates students with disabilities in shaping their own educational paths and participating in scientific research and artistic activity, thereby enabling them to contribute to the advancement of science and art.

- 6. We strengthen our position in the education market through participation in international university alliances.
- 7. We improve the university's education quality system and foster the teaching competencies of our academic staff.
- We cater to our students' experiences through personalized services and improved support during their education.

Science and art



We define science as creating and finding novel applications for new knowledge, while art can be understood as the creation of material and visual culture.

Strategic goal: By 2029, we aim to be a research university capable of successfully competing and collaborating with leading academic centers in Europe.

Target Status: By 2029, SWPS University leverages research, artistic, and implementation work to accurately identify issues and propose solutions that impact quality of life, sustainable development, and new technology applications. Through its achievements in the fields of social sciences, humanities, and arts, the university collaborates with leading domestic and foreign academic institutions, social organizations, public and economic entities. SWPS University initiates and coordinates interdisciplinary research and implementation projects, leading to a significant increase in funding and the scale of its scientific and artistic activity. University employees successfully integrate research, teaching, and organizational work thanks to investments in staff, infrastructure, and research equipment development. We share our knowledge and experience with students, the academic community, and the socio-economic environment.

Strategic Activities:

- 1. We pursue our research agenda, integrating social sciences, humanities, arts, and new technologies with other fields of knowledge.
- 2. We develop and implement an action plan to achieve the status or meet the standards of a research university in Poland.
- 3. We strengthen our academic reputation by pursuing high-quality scientific and artistic activity.
- 4. We foster international collaborations in the fields of research and artistic activity with partners who share our values and standards.
- 5. We initiate research and artistic projects to become the leader of international consortia.
- 6. We systematically increase the internationalization and support the mobility of academic staff.
- 7. We develop a network of research centers to attract employees with substantial scientific or artistic potential and provide them with opportunities to enhance their competencies and form teams.
- 8. We provide scientists and artists with substantive and organizational support in preparing applications, securing funds, and completing projects.
- 9. We invest in research infrastructure that is shared among campuses, institutes, and centers to increase the availability and effective utilization of existing equipment.
- 10. We create conditions to combine research and teaching activity and develop our doctoral school to educate an academic staff that will drive progress in the various fields.
- 11. We provide internal financing, specifically to support the acquisition of external funds for research, artistic, and implementation activities.
- 12. We diversify external sources of financing for research, artistic, and implementation activity, securing additional funding from the private sector.
- 13. We motivate the academic staff to pursue application projects and development activity.
